- **NOTE:** A total of 63 s.h. of credit with a minimum overall (cumulative) GPA of 3.00 is required for graduation. Courses for which the final grade falls below a B will not be counted towards program completion.
- **NOTE:** In order to be eligible for graduation you must complete an Application for Graduation via the Student Portal. This is due by July 15 for participation in the fall ceremony and by December 31 for participation in the spring ceremony (there is no fee to apply for graduation). Once your application has been received, a degree audit will be completed for you. This audit will confirm which requirements are still outstanding in order for you to complete your degree.
